1984

"Do we have a Wesak Day Party?"

Not wanting to dissappoint the children, the motivation to organise a Wesak Day party begins & so did the story of TRWS.



With the help of a few volunteers, the 1st Wesak Day party was held. More than 4,000 children and adults from orphanages & schools celebrated.

1994

The Headline Wrote: "Monk dreams to setup Shelter Home"

One day, a reporter asked about plans to setup shelter homes. Immediately, Chief expressed that it was his dream and vision to have a shelter home catering to those who were less fortunate.



Chief & a couple of volunteers found a 3-storey house at Salak South. It was then discovered that the property was subjected to an auction and would soon be presented to court. The bid was successful & TRWS's 1st shelter home was realised.

The Welfare Society's 1st children's home, with just 12 children was officiated by Tan Sri Datin Paduka Hajjah Zaleha Bt. Ismail, also the Minister of National Unity and Community Development and Datuk K. Sri Dammaratana.

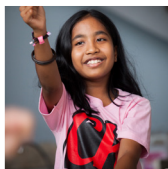


1997

As our family grew bigger over the years, we had more plans in the pipeline. TRWS held its 1st Anniversary Celebration in 1997 to reach out to many communities. The shelter was blessed by receiving many prominent guests who visited throughout this journey.

2002

We're grateful to volunteers and the media for their continuous effort to spread the words. TRWS made its 1st extension of welfare care to elderly folks who needed care and support. The Senior Home was setup and was well received by the community.



2003

Moving to a Bigger Place, To Give More

With more children in the care of the shelter, we moved to a bigger place in Desa Petaling. 18 kind-hearted souls contributed an interest-free loan to secure the property and we continue to serve the community in any way we can.

2004

Not long after, we had single mothers & troubled girls approaching the home for support and financial aid. TRWS knew we had to spread our wings to reach out to them. The Women's Shelter was established. Family counselling & legal advice were also provided to our girls and women to help them overcome their crisis.



TRWS seeks to gather the community's collective effort for financial aid and relief support to those in need when faced with unforeseen tragedies and natural disasters. Some of the relief effort by TRWS are providing temporary shelter, prayers and blessing to promote calmness and peace of mind.



With the encouragement from the public, TRWS joined hearts with Mr & Mrs Oh Kim San and friends to established the Girls' Home. The home is dedicated to help young adolescent girls aged 7 till 18 years to complete their studies & drive away ill intended distractions that may prey on them for their innocence.

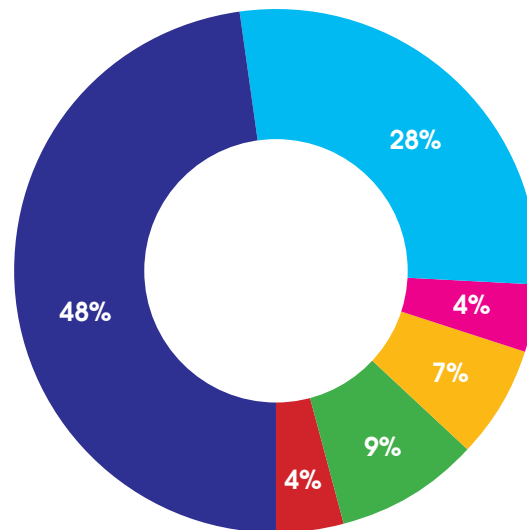
2020

The 5-storey Senior Sanctuary located opposite the orphanage in Desa Petaling is an on going fundraising effort dedicated to provide better lodging & medical support to 500 eligible senior citizens. 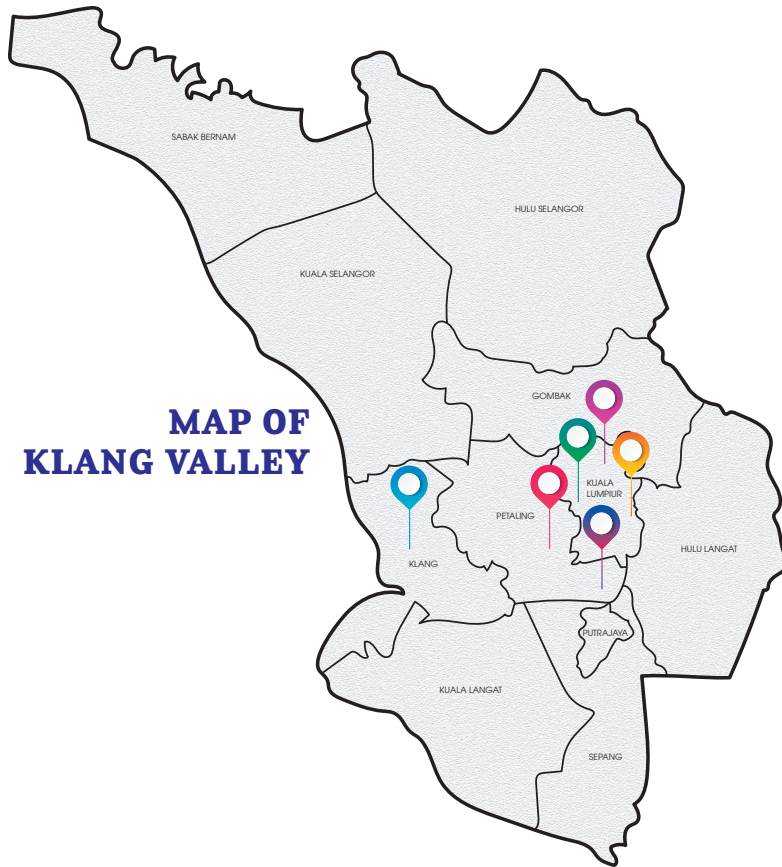

MOBILE CLINIC

Together with The Lion's Club Malaysia, TRWS and other friendly temple assistants and supporters, the Mobile Clinic was set up. They travelled between communities to help those in need of medication and general health check-ups. The aim was to reach out to those who couldn't afford basic healthcare.

HEALTHCARE CARNIVAL

The general wellbeing of the surrounding community was one of the key motivation of TRWS promise – "lift a hand, light a heart" that we



ensure that this is a sustainable annual project.

MEALS ON WHEELS

The Meals On Wheels programme was established to provide basic nourishment and other crucial necessities for the poor and homeless. Incepted in 2009, this programme have fed over thousands of people.



PT3 & SPM SEMINAR

In doing its part for the community, TRWS hosted annual PMR and SPM seminars for students. Conducted

by professionals and experts in the field of education and training. Examination candidates could expect valuable tips supported by sets of notes encompassing key features of the individual subjects taught during the seminars.



ANNUAL DINNER

A fundraising dinner was held every year attended by more than a 1,000 guests. The night involved performances and an auction to celebrate those who have championed the efforts of the welfare society for more 20 years, while raising funds for future projects including a home for the elderly and daily expenses on running TRWS.

FOOD & FUN FAIR DAY

The objective of this event is to create an opportunity to bring together supporters, well wishers, volunteers, donors, family members of Ti-Ratana for a day of fun-filled activities and to raise funds in order to strengthen our programmes and

WESAK DAY

Wesak Day is a holy day in the calendar of Buddhists worldwide where devotees observe precepts and teachings of Lord Buddha and reiterate their determination to lead noble lives. Devotees participate in this annual procession which signifies oneness among all devotees.



to develop new & innovative projects to best serve the community. Family Day Food & Fun Fair will have 60 stalls, with variety of foods, drinks and fun games.

KATHINA DAY

This annual event is traditionally celebrated after the return of the members of the Sangha from their rain retreat in October. It gives an opportunity for Buddhist followers and supporters to offer robes and requisites to the members of the Sangha. Usually chanting of prayers followed by puja and offering of robes and requisites will be held during the ceremony.



Ti-RATANA SENIOR SANCTUARY

The Ti-Ratana Senior Sanctuary is a 5-storey building costing approximately RM12 million. For the past three years, TRWS have committed to this newest project, which is built on a 2,000 sq ft land in Desa Petaling, Kuala Lumpur.

This new home once complete will be fully-equipped with various facilities, such as



accommodation, canteen and medical care which will be provided for free with a strong emphasis on community care to benefit up to 500 poor and eligible senior citizens.

This new sanctuary will provide long-term support and helpful resources to the growing ageing population in Malaysia and to meet the immediate needs of its current 180 senior residents.

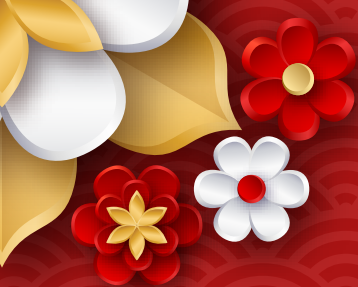
Ti-RATANA BENTONG SANCTUARY

Ti-Ratana Bentong Sanctuary is one of the two dream projects that the Founder & Advisor, Most Venerable Datuk K. Sri Dhammaratana is hoping will be realised. The other one is the Seniors' Sanctuary in Salak South Baru, Kuala Lumpur, which is now almost ready to provide free elderly care for 500 senior citizens.

Perched on top of a hill with panoramic view of the sprawling valleys below, Ti-Ratana Bentong Sanctuary is built on the site of a previous rubber plantation. Its terraced hillside thickly forested with old rubber trees attract rich native wild life as long-tailed Macaques live alongside squirrels, indigenous birds and their human brethren. The Sanctuary is designed as a spiritual home for the resident monastics and all visitors alike and is estimated to cost about RM23 million.
